

Trials Slated For 4 Draft Protesters

City court trial dates have been set for four anti-draft demonstrators on charges of unlawful assembly and disorderly conduct stemming from a demonstration Dec. 4 at the Selective Service office at 129 N. Scott Ave.

Judith Abbey will be tried Jan. 5 on unlawful assembly charges and March 12 on the disorderly conduct charge.

Carole Cole will be tried Jan. 11 for alleged disorderly conduct and Jan. 12 on the unlawful assembly charge.

Drew Pallette is to stand trial Jan. 15 for unlawful assembly and Jan. 16 for disorderly conduct.

Martin Lasater will be tried on both charges March 12.

Both charges are misdemeanors.
