

Six Draft Foes Plead Innocent

Six persons who took part in an antidraft demonstration which erupted into wild disorder in downtown Tucson Dec. 4 pleaded innocent in City Court today to charges of disorderly conduct and unlawful assembly.

Arraignment for a seventh, Betsy McDonald, was continued to Jan. 11.

vid Rehfield, Bradley Littlefield, Mark Shenfield, Paul Martin and Jonathan Nix.
