

# Cloud-Seeding Experts In 3-Day Meet At UA

Some of the leading authorities in the world on cloud seeding will attend a three-day conference at the University of Arizona beginning tomorrow.

The scientists will come from five different countries—Australia, England, Italy, Switzerland and the United States.

Ten U.S. research centers will be represented.

One of the more famous scientists taking part will be Dr. Vincent Schaefer of Schenectady, N.Y., who was a pioneer in cloud seeding.

The UA Institute of Atmos-

pheric Physics is sponsoring the conference which will be concerned with the subject "The Surface Chemistry of Ice Nucleation."

This means that the scientists will be concerned with the methods of nucleating ice crystals—which can become rainfall.

The UA Institute in recent years has carried on cloud seeding experiments over the Santa Catalina Mountains here.

Co-chairmen of the conference are Dr. James E. McDonald, physicist in the Institute, and Dr. Myron L. Corrin, UA chemistry teacher.
