

UFOs Responsible For Electrical Blackouts?

WASHINGTON (AP) — Dr. James E. McDonald of the University of Arizona told the House Science and Astronautics Committee that massive power failures this country has experienced may be due to unidentified flying objects.

He testified Monday there were hundreds of reports of UFO sightings during a New York power failure which began Nov. 9, 1965.

"There also were reports in upstate New York of a glowing object at the instant the lights went out," he added.

Noting the power outage began in upstate New York, McDonald said "the source of the

pulse which triggered the safety mechanism has not been identified."

He declined to say if power failures are caused by some form of extraterrestrial life, but added "there is a puzzling and quite disturbing coincidence between the sightings and power blackouts."

McDonald in a formal statement, agreed with Dr. J. Allen Huck, head of the University of

Illinois at Chicago sociology department, that the government should set up an agency to study UFO reports.
